


# Completing your District Dates Form on Tabroom.com

2020-2021

## **Completing your District Dates Form**

As an NSDA district chair, you'll be using Tabroom.com for district tournament registration, tabulation, and reporting results. The Tabroom.com team is striving to help your tournament run efficiently and simplify your reporting of qualifiers to the NSDA National Tournament. During setup, and while running your tournament, you should consult this document for guidance. More help and documentation regarding Tabroom.com is available at docs.Tabroom.com.

Before beginning to set up your district tournament, make sure you can log into Tabroom by pointing your browser to <a href="https://www.Tabroom.com">https://www.Tabroom.com</a>, then clicking "Login" near the top of the page.



Enter your email address and password and click "Login". If you're having trouble logging in, use the "Trouble Logging In?" link located at the bottom of the form. If you still cannot log in, please use the "Reset Password" link and check your email for a customized link to reset your password.

You will be taken to your "Tabroom homepage" after successfully logging in. Your account will be connected to your NSDA district, and you should see your district located in the right sidebar of the homepage. You may click that link to see your district's NSDA profile in Tabroom and begin the process of creating your district tournament.



After clicking into your districts details page, click the

"Tournaments" button in the upper right, and then click "Create District Tournament".

This will begin the process of creating your district tournament records in the Tabroom.com system. Any information you cannot provide at this time can be entered later; it is not imperative that all fields be filled on the first pass.

All district tournament information must be complete and finalized by November 30 if all of your tournament series will be held in the next calendar year. If any part of your tournament series starts in the current year, finalized info must be entered by October 31.

If your tournament series will begin in 2020, your District Tournament info is due by Sat October 31, 2020

If your tournament series will begin in 2021, your District Tournament info is due by Tue December 1, 2020

**Create Your District Tournament** 

After selecting a timezone, you'll need to enter the Dates and Weekends of your district tournament.

Weekends are a representation in Tabroom of which weekend you'll be using to host which events. Naming these something like "Debate" or "Speech" will help you set up events next.

The Board of Directors voted that the pilot Congressional Debate qualification rules will be permanent beginning in 2020-2021. Districts may choose whether they would like to use the pilot qualification rules in speech or debate.

Districts may also choose whether they will use Tabroom.com or SpeechWire. Your entire tournament must be run on one software. SpeechWire may only be used if your district is using the pilot qualification rules in speech and debate.

If you are not using the pilot qualification rules in speech, select the rules you will use.

Finally, districts have the option to pilot the Congress time limits as described on this page.

#### Rules

The software you choose must be used for all events of the district tournament series.

Remember: scheduling & tabbing by hand is no longer an option for Districts

The NSDA is continuting to pilot a simplified version of the district tournament series in 2020-2021.

The format of these rules is designed to more closely follow those of a traditional tournament, to be more familiar to coaches and students, and therefore easier to run. Districts can pilot the speech and/or debate method. The pilot Congress rules have gone into effect for the 2020-2021 district season. The pilot speech and debate rules will go into effect next year.


Next, you will select your tournament method. Remember, any portion of your district tournament held in 2020 must be held online. The first question asks you, if the Executive Director approves districts holding tournaments in person in 2021, will you hold them in person or online? Even if it's permitted for you to hold your tournament in person, you are welcome to hold any portion of your tournament online!

Districts holding their speech tournament online have a choice to run synchronous (live) or asynchronous (recorded) events. All speech events must be held the same way, except Extemporaneous Speaking preparation must be held live.

If you need to order resources for your district tournament from the NSDA National Office, you can communicate that through the Orders & District Awards section of this page. All resources, including ballots and district awards will be shipped to the address you provide free of charge. However, if you request additional ballots or plaques after the District Dates Form deadline (October 31 or November 30), your district will be responsible for the shipping fees.





Click the "Step Two: Assign Events to Dates" link when you're done.

On the Events schedule page, you will assign which events will take place on which weekend of your district tournament.

If your district tournament does not offer an event, mark it as "Not Offered".

All date options can be edited, so if you're unsure of specific registration information, you can use your best available information.

Each weekend will have a Details and a Dates & deadlines section, please do fill out all of them.

When you're done, click on "Go to Final Step".
